Remote Learning Offer

I am writing to inform you of our plans for remote learning, should further restrictions around Covid-19 require us to move to this form of education. The main aim in our provision is to be as consistent as possible, and to ensure that our offer matches the planned curriculum as far as is practically possible.

In light of this, our plan is to use formats for delivery of work, which our students will already be familiar with - Class Charts for the posting of classwork, and in many areas, Google Classroom will supplement this as a means for students to receive and submit their work.

For the vast majority of learners, this will be their curriculum offer:

- Students will follow their normal curriculum timetable.
- Staff will post work on **Class Charts** for their five lessons that day, by 8.30am each morning. This will contain the instructions, resources and any links to Google Classroom that are required.
- Students should work through their tasks for that day, spending **only one hour** on each lesson, and no more.
- For Core subjects (English, Maths and Science) students will be asked to submit one piece of work for feedback per week. For all other subjects, this will be one piece per fortnight.

We appreciate that the above offer may need to be adjusted for some learners. Should we move into a phase where we are required to provide Remote Learning, and you feel your child is struggling to manage the workload, we ask that in the first instance you contact your child's Pastoral Team so that amendments to their offer can be made.

In the meantime can you ensure that your child has access to their Class Charts log-in and that you also have your parent account set up. Should you not have this information, please email itsupport@paxmanacademy.school and we will get back to you soon as we can.
